Does your child or teen regress during the summer?

Does he/she have a hard time transitioning back to school in the fall?

2011 Summer Program Dates:

Children & Teens: Starting May 31st and ending in August (depending on when school starts for your child or teen) with an option to continue with after-school services in the fall.

Summer Program Structure

Our program is structured to provide morning services M-Th from 9am-1:30pm and Fri from 9am-1pm or afternoon services M-Th from 12:00-4:30pm and Fri 12:00-4pm.

Our summer program is targeted to meet the individual needs of each participant. Each day is structured at the center working on various goals and going out into the community.

A group setting may not be ideal for each participant. Community Partnerships works to provide the best learning environment for each individual. We also provide home-based services.

Developmental Therapy:

Developmental Therapy involves lots of hands-on experience. We help children and teens become more independent and involved in their community. We do this by working with children and teens to develop their skills in daily living, socialization, self-help, communication, etc.

This summer Community Partnerships will have a team leader for each age group. The Team Leader and Developmental Specialist will coordinate a monthly calendar of activities, such as day trips to the Boise Zoo, Discovery Center, etc. They will work with your child or teen to create a functional learning program that fits his/her needs and wishes.

Community Partnerships provides services out of the Payette office to the following areas: Payette, Fruitland, New Plymouth and Parma

How does my child qualify?

Through an intake process, we can determine if your child is eligible to participate in our summer program. Your child must be Medicaid eligible and have a diagnosed developmental disability.

How do I sign up?

She will be able to answer questions regarding the summer program and start the application process.
